Spartina

From 2000 to 2005, a non-native plant rapidly changed the (1) of California's San Francisco Bay. The invasive species, called *Spartina alterniflora*, threatened to turn tidal mud flats into meadow, eliminate shorebird foraging habitat, and push the native *S. foliosa* toward (2) . This species of plant, also known as smooth cordgrass, was introduced to San Francisco Bay's eastern (3) by contractors and workers for the U.S. Army Corps of (4) during the 1970s, as part of a dredging (5) program.
